

The Credit Flexibility Policy allows students to earn high school credit in three main ways, or in a combination of these ways: completion of traditional coursework; testing out or otherwise demonstrating mastery of course content; or pursuing one or more “educational options”, such as distance learning, educational travel, independent study, internships, service learning, afterschool programs or other “engagement projects”. Credit Flexibility options are designed for students who demonstrate the ability, interest and maturity to accept personal responsibility for their learning in (a) selected curricular area(s). The purpose of the credit flexibility option is to develop learners who identify their own learning objectives and implement a plan to attain those objectives outside of the traditional classroom. Students must initiate a request to take a course and/or earn course credit through the credit flexibility option by completing the Crestview High School **Flexible Credit Application and Plan**, which is available in the High School Guidance Office. A guidance counselor and/or teacher(s) and other school personnel will meet with the student to review the plan, which must be signed by the student, school officials and the parents to signify mutual agreement with the plan.
