

WEB PAGE/MEDIA PERMISSION FORM

The STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE AND INTERNET SAFETY AGREEMENT form that you previously signed included the following section:

Confidentiality of Student Information. Personally identifiable information concerning students may not be disclosed or used in any way on the Internet without the permission of a parent or guardian or, if the student is 18 or over, the permission of the student himself/herself.

The purpose of this form is to obtain your permission to possibly publish school work or information regarding a student on our district web site or to release information to media outlets. The information published would be restricted to the following items (at most): name, picture, school building, grade, class, activity, special recognition, and sports.

The following are examples of the type of information that might be posted on the Web:

- a group photo along with students' first and last name of Mrs. Jones' 5th grade class at Crestview Elementary
- the 9th grade football team photo with first and last name
- a group photo along with students' first and last name of Mr. Mosier's class on a field trip
- a photo with the first and last name of a student who received a special award
- Poems, webpages, summaries, power point presentations
